


## LOCATION

The competition centre is located in a tent on the meadow at the end of the Koerselsedijk in Houthalen-Helchteren, signposted from Grote Baan, N715 between Helchteren and Hechtel.

Parking is available next to Koerselsedijk, as directed by the parking attendant. Distance to the CC: 100-500 m.

The Competition Centre will open on Friday August 15<sup>th</sup>, at 11 a.m. On the other days, it will open at 9 a.m. and it will remain open until two hours after the last start.



#### **BIB NUMBERS, FINISH, AND REGISTRATION**

All participants in the three-day courses will receive a bib number. Tey can be collected by the club representative or individual participants at the CC before the start of the first race.

SPORTident will be used. SI-Air is activated.

Rented SPORTidents will be distributed along with the bib number. They must be returned after the last stage.

Registration (read out your SI) after the finish is mandatory, even in case of withdrawal.

### **GENERAL TECHNICAL INFORMATION**

The scale of the maps is 1/7500 for all courses

The controls are spaced at least 60 meters apart for similar objects and 30 meters apart for clearly different objects.

Due to their frequent relocation, the individual hunting towers are not shown on the map. The anchored towers are.

Special symbols/features :

- X: Bench
- O: All other man-made objects
- O: Large, remarkable tree
- **O**: Remarkable tree, usually a holly
- X: Tree stump: Generally more than 1 meter tall, or if smaller, clearly distinguishable from its surroundings.
- • : Knoll : can be either a small hill, or a large root ball with a lot of soil attached to it, with the appearance of a knoll.
- I : Paved bike path

The composition of the jury will be posted at the CC. Complaints can be submitted through the organisation or directly to the jury until 10 minutes before the start of the prize giving ceremony.

The courses will be published after the competitions on Livelox.

Each day, the finish will be at the CC.

The courses will close 3 hours after the last start for the long-distance races and 2 hours after the last start for the middle-distance race.

#### COMPETITIONS

Day 1: Middle distance; first start at 3.00 p.m.

- Day 2: Shortened long distance; first start at 10:00 a.m.
- Day 3: Shortened long distance; first start at 10:00 a.m.

Day courses SE, SD, LE, LD, SX, and W/M -10 and W/M -10 B have a free start.

#### **ON-SITE REGISTRATION**

On-site registration will only be possible for courses SD, LD, SE, LE, and SX. (SX is the day course at level W/M-10)

- W/M-18 and younger: €10
- W/M-20 and older: €15

### PRIZE GIVING CEREMONY

The first three participants in each unaccompanied age category will receive a prize after day 3. Participants in the W/M -10 and W/M -10 B categories will all receive a participation prize.

### **INFO DAY 1 : HELCHTERENBOS WEST – AUGUST 15, 2025**

Mapping : Frank Aerden (spring 2025)

Course setter : Frank Aerden, Event Advisor : Anne-Marie Delanghe

Terrain : We start in a partially open area, difficult to navigate due to ferns, surrounded by a predominantly pine forest. The central section of the map is an open area with heath, grass and a dune belt. Scattered throughout are some small copses, trees and saplings. The runnability is moderate to good, depending on the height of the grass and heath. The path network consists primarily of military tracks. We finish in a flat and open deciduous forest with very good runnability.

Due to the wet spring, ferns and grasses are high. Due to the subsequent dry period, most of the marshes have dried out, but are still clearly visible. Ponds may also be slightly smaller than shown on the map.

Distance from CC to the start = 1400 m (signposted)

Start : 3 p.m. – 5:15 p.m.

Control descriptions are separately available at the start and are only on the map for W/M -10(B) and SX.

#### INFO DAY 2 : KOERSEL FONTEINTJE – AUGUST 16, 2025

Mapping : Christian Stoffels (spring 2025)

Course setter : Jean-Pierre Kellens, Event Advisor : Anne-Marie Delanghe

Terrain : A typical 'Kempen' forest, mostly pine trees, but with scattered patches of deciduous trees. The path network is extensive. The linear traces are sometimes difficult to distinguish, especially when crossing them. Since the map was created, visibility at eye level has been significantly reduced by the low-hanging foliage caused by the wet spring. The runnability is slightly to severely obstructed. The areas with undergrowth are mostly ferns that can reach up to 2m in height. These sections are passable but require considerable physical effort. Areas with blueberries are not drawn as undergrowth. Pay attention to the very detailed terrain, partly hidden by the blueberry bushes.

#### **INFO DAY 3 : KRAANBERG-HELCHTERENBOS OOST – AUGUST 17, 2025**

Mapping : Christian Stoffels (map extension) en Frank Aerden (spring 2025)

Course setter : Frank Aerden, Event Advisor : Anne-Marie Delanghe

Terrain : We start in a newly drawn extension of the map: a primarily pine forest with moderate to good runnability. The area contains many linear traces that can be difficult to distinguish, especially when crossing them. Due to the wet spring, the foliage is denser than usual, which partially obstructs the visibility in this part of the forest. After this part, you must cross a paved road. This is done with a mandatory passage that is signposted. There won't be a time neutralization. Crossing the road elsewhere is prohibited. A steward is there to stop traffic. The next part is a technical challenging section in an open area with heath, grass and land dunes. Scattered throughout are some small copses, trees and saplings. The path network consists primarily of military tracks. We finish again in a flat and open deciduous forest with very good runnability.

Distance from CC to the start = 1500 m (signposted)

Start : 10:00 a.m. – 12:15 p.m.
